The vice president of the Great Falls Mustang Club said he paid the fee in the exaggerated manner to protest a "discriminatory vehicle tax". He claims the Montana vehicle assessment system that went into effect July 1 has overinflated the values of several older cars and has driven taxes too high. He said he paid \$35 to license and register his Shelby last year but was charged \$208 this year.
