Here's hoping you all have had a safe and happy holiday season. I want to thank you for having enough faith in me to give me this position. I'll try not to let you down.



Kevin called us back together after break- A new member asked about golf shirts with our logo on it. He was advised that he could take anything to Custom Logo on Southport and they would take care of it.


Kevin introduced Brenda Jones who showed a tape on a car switch- Involving Richard's Mustang. (her husband)

Also a sign up sheet for speakers of 5 outside & 5 club members. The speakers would be alternate the months.


Cheryl said she would like the club to do a party or picnic once a quarter. Maybe a spring cruise with picnic.
