I want to wish everybody a Merry Christmas and a safe Happy New Year. I will be scheduling a Board of Directors meeting at the end of January, I will contact you.





CENTRAL VIRGINIA MUSTANG CLUB BOARD OF DIRECTOR'S MEETING
OCTOBER 30, 1994

The Board of Director's of the Central Virginia Mustang Club met on Sunday, October 30, 1994, at the home of Richard and Brenda Jones. The meeting was called to order at 4:25 pm. The following members were present: President Kenny Fischer, Secretary Debbie Shaver, National Director Don Lane, and Directors Carroll Lipscombe, David Lythgoe, and Richard Jones. Other members interested in commenting on the September car show present were: Nellie Fischer, Brenda Jones, Karen Lane, Dot Lipscombe, Steve Shaver, Lonnie and Joan Tucker, and Terry Wagner.

The Club received a letter from Billy Kirkland expressing dismay over not being encouraged to join the organization while at the car show. Perhaps he didn't see the membership table set up for that purpose. No one seemed to know who he was/is to justify his displeasure.

The location of the car show was discussed. The majority of those present were in favor of moving our of Shockhoe Slip no matter where we end up next year. Parking, both for participants and for spectators was cited as a problem, threatening to tow member's cars as we were trying to pack and clean up the area after the show, lack of space to organize vehicles by year or group, lack of space for the show to grow, lack of directional signage, and the lack of cooperation from Shockhoe Slip merchants -- blocking streets and alleys, not allowing the use of restroom facilities. Members are asked to be aware of any locations in their areas that might be suitable as a site for the car show next fall. Several sites mentioned that will be investigated are: Richmond Center, Columbian Center, ACCA Temple, Chester Wal-Mart, Southside Plaza, Bill Talley Ford, Strawberry Hill, the grassy area in front of Johnston-Willis Hospital, and Chesterfield and Henrico County Parks. We would like to have a site confirmed by the Board of Director's meeting at the end of January.

The judging sheets were another point of concern. Lonnie spent time on the beaches of Puerto Rico redesigning the sheets into a multicarbon form that would have the owner/car information filled in before the judge receives his assigned sheets for his class. Terry suggests increasing the categories for judging from 1 to 6 (high to low). The judges would pick up their sheets from registration and a runner would return the sheets to the trailer as necessary as cars are judged, not wait until the end of the day and the people in the trailer get deluged by paperwork. It was suggested that a technical inspector be stationed at registration to aid in assigning classes for participants unsure of their class. Perhaps the MCA definition of "daily driven, street driven, and trailered" should be included on the registration form. Perhaps to help judges know which cars are in their respective class to be judged, the classes could be coded by the registration number. If the judges are handed a stack of judging sheets those are all the cars in the class to be judged, avoiding skipping cars.

Judges should sign up for a one year "term". They must attend at least four judges meetings. They should also each possess a copy of the MCA rules and regulations and a decoder book.

It was suggested that next year the show flyers should include the classes available, registration form with a liability statement, and any other pertinent information. We have on hand several show flyers from other car clubs to use as examples if needed.

Debbie has information on the Chester Christmas Parade, scheduled for Sunday, December 4, 1994, at 2:00 pm. For \$12 we can enter 20 cars. See Debbie if anyone is interested. It was decided to skip the Colonial Heights Christmas Parade. The cost is \$25 for five cars and the parade is Thursday, December 1, 1994.

The Central Virginia Mustang Club met Wednesday, November 2, 1994 at Richmond Ford. The meeting was called to order at 7:33 pm by President Kenny Fischer. New members/guests were welcomed: Billy Lam who owns a '67 Fastback, and Clyde Willis who owns a '72 convertible. Birthday greetings were extended to those born in November and a special congratulation was extended to Don and Karen Lane who will be celebrating their anniversary on November 30.

Second Vice-President Don Smith reported 78 paid members. Treasurer Donnie Nichols reported a beginning balance of \$2917 plus \$5 deposited minus \$1173 for an ending balance of \$1749. National Director Don Lane reported that MCA is making changes in the magazine, Mustang Times, changing to enameled paper. Member Paul Oliver was recognized for attending the recent MCA Board of Director's meeting in Atlanta. Possibly Paul will be able to attend more of these meetings in his business travels. Paul reported that MCA is very interested in regional club activities. Next year they have budgeted funds to visit clubs, attend functions, etc., much as Andy Richardson and his wife who were in attendance at our September car show. MCA also made the diecast model of the 1964½ Mustang with 30th Anniversary decals available to CVMC members for \$32.50, reduced from the original price of \$50.00. We must purchase at least 12 of the cars to get the special price. There were only 2000 models made and only 100 are left, not enough for MCA to run another advertising campaign. These models are projected to become collector's items.

Kenny reported that the car show season is over. However, the club had three members entered in the Lynchburg show and all three brought home a first place trophy. Eight cars went to Gloucester and brought home several awards, including a second place club award. The Mopar club of Norfolk had more members present.

Nellie has merchandise in the car. She needs information for the newsletter. The club is collecting Toys For Tots again this year. Please bring unwrapped new toys to the December meeting or to the Holiday Party.

Carroll reported the only up-coming cruise is Saturday Night at Bill's Barbeque. Debbie Shaver has information about the Chester Christmas Parade, scheduled for Sunday, December 4. The line-up starts at 1:00 pm, with the parade slated to step off at 2:00 pm. The registration is only \$12.00 for 20 cars. Please let Debbie know if you would like to participate.

Karen reported that the Holiday Party sign-up sheets are posted. The party will be Saturday, December 10 at the Belmont Recreation Center from 6:30-10:30 pm. Music will be available however, if you have a preference, please bring it. BYOB with mixers available. There will be a gift exchange, with men bringing a gift for a man and women bringing a gift for a woman -- all with a \$15.00 limit. The children will be taken care of.

Marty Belt reported for NASCAR that the drivers are switching. Dropping the car weight limit by 100 pounds will accommodate the Monte Carlo, and the carburetor may drop down to 390. Earnhardt won the championship, but Ford won the manufacturer's championship.

Monte presented trivia. The semi-annual Adopt-A-Highway pick-up will be held November 12. Members will meet at the Midlothian K-Mart at 9:30 am and usually takes a couple of hours. Lunch at the Pizza Hut will follow.

Brenda Jones spoke for the Election Committee. Ron Martin, Linda Cosier, Karen, and Brenda contacted the membership to arrive at the following slate of nominees: President -- Kenny Fischer; First Vice-President -- Don Lane; Second Vice-President -- Earl Morris and Terry Wagner; Secretary -- Debbie Shaver; Treasurer -- George Cosier; National Director -- Paul Oliver; Directors -- Herbert Hudson, Richard Jones, Mark McChesney. The floor is open for nominations. A motion was made and seconded to close the nominations. Kenny reminded everyone that a change in committee chairpersons would be good. The sponsor and publicity committees need a chairperson.

Brenda presented doorprizes. The Community Club Awards were discussed. The program ends January 9, so everyone is encouraged to save the necessary proofs of purchase and turn them in to Brenda.
