SEPTEMBER 6, 2000

President George Cosier called the September meeting of the Central Virginia Mustang Club to order at 7:35 PM. There was one new member/guest present: Larry Crow, and his wife, who own a '73 Mach I. George reported that the MCA Grand National Show held over Labor Day weekend in Raleigh/Durham had a total of 408 pre-registered vehicles. Don Lane received a Gold Award with his '65 fastback, A.C. Harris received a Gold Award with his '65, Mike Young received a Bronze Award with his Boss, Steve Smith received a Silver Award with his Boss, Debbie Shaver received a Bronze Award with their '67 coupe and first place with their '94 Cobra coupe, Brenda Jones placed second with her '67 coupe, Tony Hall placed first with his '95 Cobra, and Lonnie Tucker placed first with their '66 Modified coupe.

Treasurer Karen Lane reported a beginning balance of \$1538.09 with deposits of \$70 (car show registration), \$60 (sponsorship), and \$9 (dues), and expenses of \$25.55 (phone), \$121.24 (pool party), \$50 (MCA show materials), and \$258.36 (dash plaques & printing), for a ending balance of \$1221.94. She received several checks for deposit tonight, so the actual balance should be much better with our car show only 10 days away.

Overview of the car show: Friday night we need volunteers to help set up, sting banners, hang speakers, etc. Joan (coordinator), Donna, Susan (cashier), and Steve (head judge) will handle registration. Carroll has arranged for the command center motor home to be delivered to Jones' Auto. Karen will bring \$500 in change. Mike will meet with the trophy man on Monday and will have the trophies. Bob will manage the computer operation for scoring. Joan has arranged for the disc jockey, who will continue to donate his time and talents. Virginia Blood Service has a goal of 25 pints. Trigon will provide the power cord for the motor home. Brenda will confirm with Waste Management for the delivery of the portable toilets. We have 5 BFI boxes left from last year for trash receptacles, Lonnie will bring some HP boxes to supplement. Brenda has the door prizes. Steve needs volunteers to help with judging, such as writers, all help is appreciated. Nellie will place the newspaper advertisements. Two food vendors have agreed to come. Lonnie & Debbie purchased a quilt to be raffled, so we need raffle tickets to be printed. Perhaps we could suggest that the VBS contact radio stations for public service advertisements for our show. Brenda will coordinate the 50/50 raffle. Herbert will manage the drinks sales, last year we made about \$120.

Lew reported on parades we know are coming up on the calendar. November 18 should be the Ashland parade, December 3 in Mechanicsville, and December 10 in Chester. The Richmond Christmas parade will be December 2, but we don't usually participate as a club in that event.
