July 2018 Car Hobbyist News From the Council

This July 1st the antique vehicle exhaust bill becomes state law. You are now free to select and install aftermarket exhaust parts. Keep in mind that the exhaust system must operate properly.

Also becoming law is the military vehicle bill. This will allow titling and registration of off-road military vehicles so that you can drive and use them. SEMA backed the bill and there have been similar bills introduced in other states. Apparently some of those surplus vehicles were difficult to title and register.

Think fooling with emissions is no big deal? You may recall from 2015 the Volkswagen exhaust emissions cheating. This is an excerpt from Fortune in 2015: About 580,000 VWs in the U.S.—and almost 10.5 million more worldwide—weren't really "green" at all. As the world began to learn in September, when the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency issued a shocking "notice of violation," the vehicles met emissions standards for dangerous oxides of nitrogen, known collectively as NOx, only when running their paces in an artificial, indoor lab setting. Volkswagen has admitted this.

Software in the engine recognized the telltale signs of the testing regimen and turned up the emissions-reduction equipment when its exhaust was under scrutiny. But once the car was driven onto actual roads, the equipment adjusted and the vehicle disgorged up to 40 times the permissible levels of NOx.

For seven years Volkswagen's advertising campaigns flogged these vehicles' bogus eco-friendly credentials in print, media, and even Super Bowl commercials. In one memorable example, the "green police" stop a long line of smog-belching cars but wave a lone, righteous diesel from VW's Audi division through with a cheery, "You're good to go, sir." Just recently this story was in the news again as Audi Chief Executive Rupert Stadler, head of the Volkswagen Group, was arrested. German prosecutors reportedly arrested Stadler due to a potential risk that he might seek to suppress or tamper with evidence related to the scandal. The prosecutors' office said that Stadler had been seen by a judge "who has ordered him to be remanded in custody." Even Stadler's apartment was raided. Volkswagen the previous week agreed to pay a fine of 1 billion euro (\$1.2) billion). There are pending investigations in 55 countries. Yes, governments take emissions very seriously plus they are going to get a lot of money out of the Volkswagen Group - the automaker has earmarked more than 27 billion euro in fines, buybacks, and costs. That's \$32.4 billion in US dollars.

The tariffs of President Trump could have an effect on cars and parts. This is from SEMA: President Trump has directed the U.S. Department of Commerce (DOC) to investigate whether imported automobiles and auto parts pose a threat to America's national security. The DOC investigation applies to all types of cars and parts—new cars, classic cars, OEM parts and specialty auto parts.

The DOC will issue its findings and recommendations for presidential actions,

if any. Such a recommendation could include imposing global tariffs of up to 25% on all automobiles and auto parts imported into the United States. The SAN opposes the threatened tariffs. The comment period ended on June 29th so we should soon find out the DOC's decision.

Four US senators, Ted Cruz of Texas, Rand Paul of Kentucky and James Lankford and Jim Inhofe, both of Oklahoma; have called for an investigation of National Science Foundation grants, saying the federal agency had ventured beyond science and into political advocacy, particularly with its support of a program to encourage TV weathercasters to report on global warming. The demand for an investigation came the same day that NBC News reported how Climate Central had helped educate more than 500 TV weathercasters across the country on global warming and the impacts it is having on everything from temperatures to the growth of poison ivy to the amount of pollen in the air. The organization's six-year-old program with TV weather reporters is called "Climate Matters." It will be interesting to see where this goes as the news media has taken a hit from President Trump's fake news accusations.
