DECEMBER 2020 CAR HOBBYIST NEWS FROM THE COUNCIL

The election was/still is a mess just like everything else in 2020. I can tell you that this will be over on December 14 which is the date

set by the 12th Amendment – the amendment that describes how a president is elected. That is the date the Electoral College will vote. As I write this in November we only have to wait about three more weeks. We know that there are not going to be any big changes for our hobby if Trump prevails but what about Biden? An internet search for Biden's fracking policy nets a bunch of confusion. Keep in mind that the EPA under the Obama administration studied fracking for a couple of years and didn't take any action to ban the process. I'm assuming the EPA found fracking was okay with the environment.

I was able to find information on Biden's climate change plans on his website. Here are a couple of quotes: "Biden believes the Green New Deal is a crucial framework for meeting the climate challenges we face. It powerfully captures two basic truths, which are at the core of his plan: (1) the United States urgently needs to embrace greater ambition on an epic scale to meet the scope of this challenge, and (2) our environment and our economy are completely and totally connected."

"Ensure the U.S. achieves a 100% clean energy economy and reaches net-zero emissions no later than 2050. On day one, Biden will sign a series of new executive orders with unprecedented reach that go well beyond the Obama-Biden Administration platform and put us on the right track. And, he will demand that Congress enacts legislation in the first year of his presidency that: 1) establishes an enforcement mechanism that includes milestone targets no later than the end of his first term in 2025, 2) makes a historic investment in clean energy and climate research and innovation, 3) incentivizes the rapid deployment of clean energy innovations across the economy, especially in communities most impacted by climate change."

This looks similar to what we have seen from the governor of California and the United Nations: replace oil and gasoline with renewable energy which means electric vehicles replacing diesel and gasoline powered vehicles. Biden's website also says taxes will increase to implement climate change policy. Of course all this hinges on a lot of things including who controls the US Senate. We will learn more later in December and of course in January.

Speaking of January that is the month the General Assembly will meet. In 2020 the Assembly had three sessions including a two month special session that made some changes noted in last month's hobbyist news. A lot of people, including car hobbyists, fear the passage of the TCI, Transportation Climate Initiative, by the Assembly. Virginia would be the 12th state to pass this legislation. The simple explanation is that TCI would increase gasoline and diesel taxes to get people to buy less gas and diesel and hopefully push prices high enough to get people to buy electric vehicles. That tax money would be used for a variety of purposes.

Some have estimated that the total gas tax could be as high as fifty cents a gallon. We just had a gasoline tax added in July but due to less driving because of virus restrictions and an abundance of oil you can find gasoline at under \$2 in many places in Virginia. A study found that Americans are not interested in purchasing electric vehicles until gas prices exceed \$5 a gallon. We hope the state government will not push taxes that high to get people to abandon gas and diesel vehicles. And of course a Biden administration could push gas prices up if fracking is banned or restricted along with other actions aimed at climate change.

Things will become clearer in January when the new Congress and our General Assembly meet. We will find out what directions the nation and state will take.

The council calendar is now listing events for 2021. Since we can't predict the future we don't know if there will be more virus restrictions that will affect car hobby events like shows and cruise-ins. And with restaurant restrictions club meetings could be also affected. I've got my fingers crossed things will get better.
