Your vote must be submitted to Corporate Headquarters by September 30th. Last year's experiment with digital voting was an enormous success and I assume it will, again, take place.

The President's award application has been sent to the new office manager via Express mail and received in Suwanee, Georgia on July 28.

The last 2 MCA shows of the 2021 season are listed in Mustang Times, page 72, with their websites:

- September 3 5 is the MCA Grand National show in Mustang, Oklahoma. I believe several CVMC members are traveling to this show.
- October 7 10 is in Tucson, Arizona. Only at this show can all judging award points be used (counted) in your 2022 Grille Medallion Application.

For planning purposes, the MCA National shows for 2022, as of this writing, are as follows:

- May 20 22, in the Waterfront Plaza, 2 Harbor Center in Suisun City, CA 94585
- July 29 31 at the State University of New York at Buffalo in Amherst, New York. This show was cancelled in 2020.
- GRAND NATIONAL show is September 2 4 in Lady A Park, 7016 Evans Town Center Blvd, Evans, GA 30809 United States

On line registration for all the 2021 shows, as well as Hotel availability is through the Motosho car show registration system. Their website is www.motosho.com. For our new members if any of you are planning on going to any of the MCA shows this year. Make your show and hotel reservations early as the hotels around the show sites fill up very fast. If something comes up that you cannot attend the show you can always cancel your hotel reservations within the time limits stated on your reservation, usually within 48 hours. Motosho will have the 2022 show list up, usually, in January 2022.

Our September 18 fall show @ Bass Pro Shops is listed in the "Mustang Times" website under *Events*, in the magazine on page 74 and in the Car Club Council of Central Virginia (CCCCVA) website.
