MCA REPORT

Mustang Club of America news:

I need to correct the wording in the 2nd sentence of July's newsletter where I stated we had 325 points

for the MCA president's award for 2021. In reviewing that report before sending it to Headquarters I forgot there was no National Memorial day parade in 2021 so I had to remove the 10 points which resulted in only 315 points. That was still the highest points CVMC has ever earned for the Presidents award.

Mustang Club of America news:

I received my draft copy of our Corporate National Board of Directors Quarterly meeting of April 30, 2022 in Dallas, Texas. President Steve Prewitt called the meeting to order and welcomed the 23 members of the National Board and any visitors. Roll call was taken by Vice President Jim Keenan and a quorum was met. 17 Board members were absence. The following Regional Directors were among those in attendance: Peggy Corpman (Mustang Club of Omaha); Tina Ponder (Red River Classic Mustang Club); Chuck Dunn (Oklahoma Mustang Club; Ray Coe (Mustang Club of Houston); Bob Winland (Music City Mustang Club); Vernon Wilhelm (Northside Mustang Car Club); Pam Wilemon (Wild Horse Mustang Club. These members traveled to Texas at their own expense.

The Minutes from the January 2022 meeting were approved without objection.

- Executive Committee Report: Steve Prewitt discussed the October 2022 Regional Directors Summit which will be held at the Gale Halderman Museum outside of Dayton, Ohio Oct 14th with the <u>last</u> National Board of Directors Quarterly meeting of 2022 held on October 15th. Four Regional Directors have stepped forward to help with the logistics in hosting this event
- <u>Finance Committee Report</u>: Total of all Combined assets were reported up from our April Corporate meeting. This includes Checking, High Yield Savings, Business checking, and special events accounts.

Committee Reports

- Administrative: Dean Corpman, Committee
 Chair asked all Committee chairs to look through
 any contracts they have to identify those close to
 expiring so they can be renewed, updated or
 placed out for bid with ample time for action.
- Club Charter: Jim Keenan made a committee
 Motion to remove the charters of three clubs that
 are not/have not been able to maintain
 membership levels for MCA requirements.

Those requirements are ALL club officers are MCA members.

- Coastal Bend Mustang Club (Corpus Christi, TX), Four States Mustang Corral (Texarkana, TX) and Mustangs of East Texas (Tyler, TX.) These 3 clubs were removed. The motion passed without objection.
- Internet: Jim Keenan spoke of the web page and all of the work building and maintaining it over the past four years. As the designer and web master has announced he needs to move on to other projects, Jim made a motion to pay him for all of his work and search for a new entity to maintain the page. He also made a motion to pay for the work from money already set aside in the budget and then requested an additional \$12,000 by motion to secure a new web master to maintain the page going forward. Both motions passed without objection.
- <u>Judging</u>: National Head Judge Billy Henson brought forward a motion for a National Platinum Card Program with new Platinum cards to be assigned to all active Judges (or past MCA judges in good standing) that have served or are serving in Head Judge or Assistant National Head Judge position's. *The Motion passed* without objection.
 - Also review July's issue of "Mustang Times"; the <u>Judges Corner</u>, page 8, for additional information on passing the Judging certification and the process on how to finally receive your earned Judging card.
- Membership/Special Events: Don Blackstock reported we have a worldwide membership of 18,282 members with the following breakdown: 8,427 Standard members, 6,231 Digital members, 3,524 Associate members and 100 international members
- <u>National Shows</u>. Patsy Brown brought up two motions for National Shows dates from her committee.
 - The Rio Grande Mustang Club, June 9-11, 2023 in Albuquerque. NM
 - The Mustang Club of Central Iowa,
 August 9-11, 2024 in Des Moines, Iowa
 - o Both Motions passed without objection.
- Nominations/Elections: From the Nominations committee: All Board members (and MCA members) with terms expiring this year were reminded they have until July 11th to submit their biographies and pictures for the 2023-2024 Board of Directors seats (total of 13). Also, National or Regional Directors with at least two years in the position may submit an bio and

picture to run for the Officer positions for the same time frame.

- These pictures and bios will be published in September's issue of Mustang Times. Members will be notified via email with information on how to vote.
- <u>Publishing</u>: Jim Keenan briefed the Board on Mustang Times Swap out ads with other entities and increased cost changes involved with printing due to economic times.
- Show Automation: Lynda Blackstock and Robin Paulsell briefed the members present on Motosho and to encourage its use throughout other local MCA clubs.
- With no further business to discuss, the meeting was adjourned without objection at 11:35 am.

Next 2022 Meeting will be July 9, 2022 in Dallas, Texas.


