I received our 16th continuous year of the prestigious President's Award from MCA at Grand National show in Evans, Georgia. The award is displayed on our club webpage for all to see. Our club is a very active club by sponsoring and supporting car shows, participating in local benefits, cruise-ins, and parades such as the National Memorial Day Parade in Washington, D.C, along with our Spring and Fall shows, several local Christmas parades and Wreaths across America at the Virginia Veteran's Cemetery in Amelia, VA. We needed just 100 points, however in 2021 we secured 315 points, the largest the club has earned in the years I have submitted this report. It also recognizes our members for taking the time to study and pass the tests required to become MCA Gold Card and certified judges. Those certified judges then

volunteer to judge at MCA shows to earn their Gold cards. This is the reason I keep track of our MCA members who attend National and Grand National shows. It requires many, many hours of my time, during the year, to keep account of all our activities and to document them for submission to the MCA Presidents Award committee. 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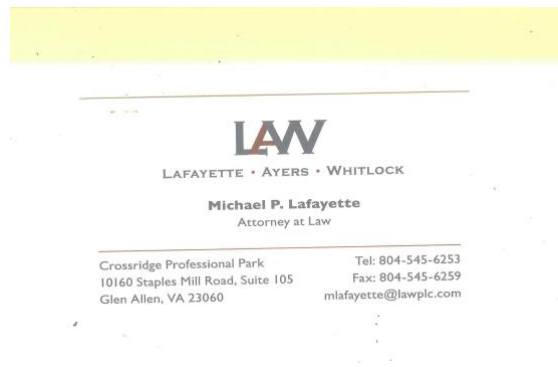
