The 1st MCA Corporate Board of Directors (BoD) meeting will be held January 14th to 16th, 2022 at the Holiday Inn, Celebration Area; 5711 W. Irio Bronson Memorial Highway, Kissimmee, Florida, 34746. The Banquet and Officers installation dinner of our newly elected officers is January 16, from 6 to 10 PM. This is held in conjunction with the Mecum Auction, January 06-15. Those who want to attend the Mecum Auction can do it on the 15th. The BoD meeting and assignments (*in the pasted*) have taken place on Sunday the 16th at the Hotel. I received the following <u>draft</u> from the July 10th 2021 in person Corporate meeting. The 4th and last Quarterly meeting was cancelled and there was no reason given.

The President, Steve Prewitt, called the meeting in Dallas, Texas to order at 9 AM and welcomed all Board members and visitors. Roll call was taken by our National Secretary Laurie Slawson resulting in 24 National Directors in attendance and a quorum was met. There were 4 Board members not in attendance. The April 2021 minutes were approved as written with no objections.

- <u>FINANCIAL</u> REPORT: The Wells Fargo Bank combined assets: business checking, High Yield saving and special events' have all been accounted for and is complete except for checks written that have not cleared the bank. The Club is in great financial condition. This report was approved with no objection.
- EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE REPORT:
 - Debbie Mays was introduced as the new MCA office administrator. Due to there being only one more board meeting this year, her former position as a National Director will not be filled at this time.

- MCA has been approached by the Concours D'Elegance show at Hilton Head Island, South Carolina to participate.
- The October 7 to 10 Tucson, Arizona show was discussed along with the current car registrations. Ideas were discussed on to increase registration numbers.
- The nomination of Dan Trap for a Lifetime Achievement Award was discussed. The motion was approved with no objection. This was in November's issue of Mustang Times on page 10.
- <u>ADMINISTRATIVE</u> REPORT: Dean Corpman briefed the Board on the way the selection of the new MCA Office administrator position was made and then introduced Debbie Mays to speak on her experience.
- Club Charter REPORT:
 - A California club has applied to be an MCA club. The application was missing some required materials so it will be revisited at our next meeting
 - There was a discussion on being able to provide individual membership information to Regional Directors.
- Driving Events Discussions for:

 - Working on an event for May 2022.
- Insurance/Industry Liaison: REPORT
 - Working with Ford on an event at the Ozarks.
 - Ford remains a strong sponsor of MCA
- Internet REPORT: committee is working on a physical address. Several website problems are being worked on and our webmaster is constantly keeping it updated to prevent attacks.
- <u>Judging</u> REPORT: the Annual Judges Meeting will be on Sunday night after the Mustang Oklahoma show.
- Membership REPORT: our present worldwide membership is approximately 21,500. 22 members joined us at Carlisle and the Mid-America race track was successful. We will be going to Mustang Week and Oktoberfest.
- National Shows REPORT: applications are needed for National shows in 2023. The committee has been working on updates to the MCA National Show Guidelines website. Motion was made to approve the proposed revisions to

the guidelines. The motion was approved with no objection.

 Show Automation: REPORT: Eight Regional shows have used Motosho so far this year.

Under NEW BUSINESS

 A motion was made to approve Pate Media's contract through 2024. The motion was approved with no objection.
