**MCA REPORT** 

Mustang Club of America news:

The 2021 MCA Presidents Award application requiring documentation in 17 different catalogues was required to be into Headquarters by 1 July this year. To qualify CVMC needed only 100 points, however, in 2021, we accumulated 325 points. This is the highest points CVMC has earned in the 16 years I have been applying for the award. It has been completed and was mailed 24 June. There is a committee that reviews and verifies that CVMC is a paid MCA chartered club and also reviews the documentation in all the catalogues I have submitted. Usually at the Grand National awards ceremony we will then find out when our name is called to receive the award.

There are 2 more MCA shows here on the East Coast. They are:

- July 29 31, the National "Nickel City Mustang Round" in the Buffalo, New York area by the Western New York Shelby and Mustang Club, their website is <a href="https://www.facebook.com/WNYSMC">https://www.facebook.com/WNYSMC</a>. This show is sold out with over 300 cars registered and that show was cancelled in 2020.
- September 2 4 GRAND NATIONAL "Ponies in the Plaza" in Evans, GA by the Central Savannah River Area Mustang and Ford Club, their website is www.csramc.org.

Hotel availability for these shows is through on line Motosho car show system. Their website is www.motosho.com.

If any of you are planning on going to any of these shows make your hotel reservations early as hotels around the show sites <u>fill up very fast</u>. If something comes up that you cannot attend the show you can always cancel your hotel reservations within the <u>time limits</u> stated on your reservation, usually within 48 hours.

Our Fall September 17<sup>th</sup> MCA Regional show in now listed in "Mustang Times" magazine under our date in Ashland, VA. The Car Club Council of Central Virginia also has listed our September show on their website under Calendar and show date.

The handicap and regular toilets along with a wash station have been ordered for delivery and pickup for our Fall show.

This is an advance piece of travel information for those driving I95 South to the GRAND NATIONAL September 2 – 4, 2022 in Evans, Georgia for a rest stop. Henry Ford had a winter estate just off I95 in the Savannah, GA area at exit # 87 into Richmond Hill, GA. There is a complete story in the 2019

February issue of Mustang Times. I have been told by Ford/Mustang aficionados that it is worth the time for a wonderful and informative visit.

Our very own Ms. Sharon Hazelgrove at the AACA antique auto show at St. Joseph Villa on 11 June was awarded a Best in Show award for her 1970 Mustang Mach 1 and also earned a First in Class # 14 award. 2 awards in one show, congratulations Sharon. I had to disqualify myself from judging her car because I knew her Mustang. But I was 1 of the 4 judges riding around the show field, in a golf cart, looking at and verifying those chosen cars to make sure those cars, along with Sharon's Mustang, qualified for the Best in Show award.

In May's issue of "Mustang Times" on page 8 is information on the Judging Certification process. There is a great article on a 4 decade "Show Survivor Mustang" on page 24 to 30.
