Mustang Club of America news:

I have started working on our club's annual report to MCA Corporate Headquarters which is due by 1 March.

The first MCA National show of this opening car show season is April 1 – 3 in Florence, S. Caroline, by the Eastern South Caroling Mustang Club. Their website is peedeeroundup.com. Jack Roush Jr. is the featured speaker. The host hotel is the Hilton Garden Inn, 2671 Hospitality Boulevard, Florence, SC 29501. Registration deadline of February 28, 2022 for this show and is through Motosho. There are only a few blocked rooms left. The indoor parking is closed.

On line registration for the above show, as well as Hotel availability is through the on line Motosho car show system. Their website is www.motosho.com. If any of you are planning on going to this show make your show and hotel reservations early as the hotels around the show sites fill up very fast. If something comes up that you cannot attend the show you can always cancel your hotel reservations within the time-limits stated on your reservation, usually within 48 hours.

Now is the time to take a good look at your Mustang and make any new additions or corrections to that beautiful car before the start of the show season. If your Mustang has been judged by MCA use their judging sheet as your guide for any necessary corrections.

Checking out the Judges Corner, page 8, is an excellent message on judging changes and some new rules.
