I received my draft copy of the MCA Corporate Board of Directors meeting held July 9th 2022 in Dallas Texas. The President, Steve Prewitt, called the meeting to order at 9 AM and welcomed the 27 Board of Directors. Roll was taken by V. President & Secretary Pro-Tempore Jim Keenan resulting in a guorum for the start of the meeting. 3 Board of Directors members were missing. There were 6 Regional Directors attending at their own expense. They were: Peggy Corpman (Mustang Club of Omaha), Tina Ponder (Red River Classic Mustang Club), Vernon Wilhelm (Northside Mustang Car Club), Steve Armstrong (Green County Mustang Club) Harold Champion (Mustang Club of Tampa/Bay Area Mustangs), Eric Shirley (Rio Grande Mustang Club), & George Antochy (North Texas Mustang Club) along with guests.

Minutes from the April 2022 Board of Directors meeting were submitted and approved <u>without</u> objection.

<u>Executive Committee Report</u>: the chair opened a discussion to assist the Youth program in setting new procedures.

- The Internet Committee is continuing its search for a new host to maintain our club web site
- Discussions were opened with regard to MCA hosting a "60 years of Mustang" anniversary event. Jeff Mays made a motion for MCA to move forward and host the event with a committee and details will be published later. Motion approved without objection
- The Regional Directors Summit will be held Saturday October 15 and the last Corporate Board of Directors meeting for 2022 is scheduled to take place on Sunday, October 16 in Dayton (Tipp City), OH.

<u>Finance Committee Report</u>: Treasurer's 2022 Report; of all combined accounts (which are: regular Checking, High Yield Savings, Business checking and special events) for a balanced accounting and reported to all attending the meeting.

Committee Reports

<u>Marketing</u>: Jeff Mays requested, from all those present, to send him any questions or ideas they may have for a survey he plans to send out to the entire membership.

Mr. Mays also reported our sponsor, Haggerty Insurance Company, is interested in sending an e-blast to their members the ability to join the MCA for a year at a discounted fee through a 30-day period.

Membership/Special Events: Don Blackstock reported we have 17,764 worldwide members with the following breakdown: 8,547 standard members, 6,021 Digital members, 3,094 Associate members and 102 international members.

<u>National Shows</u>: Patsy Brown announced March through May 2023 is a vacancy for a National Show and they would like to see some applications.

 Her committee is looking at bringing some rules changes to discuss at the October meeting for January voting and implementation starting with the 2023 year show season.

<u>Nominations/Elections</u>: when voter tabulations are completed the new Officers and Director's will be announced in Mustang Times.

From the Nominations committee: with a day to go before nominations close, they have received one person running for President and two running for Vice President, Secretary and Treasurer; and thirteen running for National Director positions.

The meeting was placed in recess at 11:45 and called back to order at 12:30

 Jim Keenan made a motion to return to Orlando, Florida, the Mecum Auction and for the Annual installation dinner of our newly elected officers for the banquet/meeting January 2023. The motion passed without objection.

With no further business to discuss, the meeting was adjourned without objection at 1:05 pm.


