MUSTANG CLUB OF AMERICA (MCA) REPORT

To every one of our CVMC members have a perfect Christmas with family and friends hoping all will have a wonderful New Year.

I received our 17th continuous year of the prestigious President's Award from MCA Corporate Headquarters by mail. This award is displayed on our club webpage for all to see. Our club is a very active club by sponsoring and supporting car shows, participating in local benefits, cruise-ins, and parades such as the National Memorial Day Parade in Washington, D.C. along with our Spring and Fall shows, several local Christmas parades and Wreaths across America at the Virginia Veteran's Cemetery in Amelia, VA. We needed just 100 points, however in 2021 we secured 315 points, the largest the club has earned in the 18 years I have submitted this report. This year we earned 286 points. It also recognizes our members for taking the time to study and pass the tests required to become an MCA Gold Card or certified judge. Those certified judges then volunteer to judge at MCA shows to earn their Gold cards. This is the reason I keep track of our MCA members who attend National and Grand National shows. It requires many, many hours of my time, during the year, to keep account of all our activities and to document them for submission to the MCA Presidents Award committee. Of the hundreds of MCA clubs around the world only a few receive this award which is why the award is so prestigious.

All of these awards are posted on our club website so our members and visitors can see we are an active Mustang.

A draft copy of the MCA Board of Directors meeting was held July 8, 2023 in Dallas, Texas. The President, Jeff Mays, called the meeting to order at 9 AM and welcomed the 24 Board of

Directors. Roll was taken by National Secretary Jim Keenan resulting in a quorum for the start of the meeting. 6 Directors were missing with 5 Regional Directors attending <u>all</u> at their own expense along with guests.

Minutes from the April Board meeting were submitted with one adjustment and approved as written <u>without objection</u>.

Executive Committee Report: The Chair stated he received two resignations since the last meeting, Steven McCarley and Bryan Kerrick and with elections upcoming they will be filled. He also spoke about the 60th Anniversary show and that contract negotiations are close to being finalized.

<u>Finance Committee Report</u>: Treasurer Al Hammond joined his committee by calling in an on-the-spot reporting of all Combined Accounts.

COMMITTEE REPORTS:

Administrative:

Dean Corpman represented the committee and made a motion to cover duties fulfilled outside the normal duties of the contract for the MCA office manager. With the loss of the automotive show registration program (Motosho), she worked to create a program in time for the Albuquerque, New Mexico national show. He made a motion to compensate her for the extra hours worked at her regular rate of pay.

- Mr. Corpman also read a Finance committee statement which Member Jimmy Austin formally made as a committee motion to fulfill the bylaws requirement for having an audit completed upon changing MCA Treasurers.
- A Georgia firm (Fulton and Kozak) has agreed to conduct an audit of the past four fiscal years at approximately \$15,000.
 Above motions were approved without objection.

Club Charter:

- Jim Keenan made a committee Motion to Charter the Kitsap Mustang Club representing the Bremerton Washington area and the Hoosier Mustang Club representing Columbus, IN area. Both clubs were accepted without objection..
- The Mid-South Mustang Club (Memphis) has dissolved and requested to be removed as a charted club. Motion was made and approved <u>without</u> objection.

Membership/Special Events:

 Don Blackstock reported we have 15,314 members with the following breakdown: 8,863 Standard members, 4,728 Digital members, 1,615 Associate members, 91 International members and 17 Youth members.

National Shows:

 Chris Ponder brought up a motion for a Grand National Show for the National Capital Region Mustang Club; August 29-31, 2025 at the Fredericksburg Expo Center, Fredericksburg, VA. The Motion passed <u>without objection</u>.

Nominations/Elections:

 John Trsar stated he has 12 two year and now 2 one-year spots on the Board to fill with this election and with a few days until nominations close is optimistic they will have enough people running to fill all of the vacancies.

Regional Directors Summit:

 The Regional Directors Summit takes place the weekend of October 21 followed by the next Board of Directors meeting in Leeds, AL. Locations and times are being finalized.

New Business

Jim Keenan brought up the January Annual meeting and made a Motion to host the Banquet and Annual meeting over the Jan 5-7 weekend at the Holiday Inn Celebration, Orlando, SW as the best option starting 2024. The motion carried <u>without objection</u>.

With no further business to discuss, the meeting was adjourned without objection at 1220 pm.

The next meeting is scheduled to take place on Sunday, October 22, 2023 in Leeds, AL, at Barber Motorsports Park.
