MUSTANG CLUB OF AMERICA (MCA) REPORT

If there is any member that would like to run for MCA's Board of Directors look in May's club publication of *Mustang Times* magazine on page 47, top right column and follow the information discussed in the column to submit.

MCA's 2023 National shows are listed in club publication on page 74. This year's Grand National (the best of the best Mustangs) is in Melbourne, Florida at the American Muscle Car Museum by the Space Coast Mustang Club. September 8 to 10, 2023. It was scheduled several years ago but was canceled during to coronavirus (COVID-19) time period. If you don't want to drive your Mustang to Florida, you could save wear and tear on your Mustang and your body driving, gas, food, time, and or hotels you can use Amtrak's auto train (1-800-268-7252). The train is a direct ride, with you and your Mustang, from Lorton, VA to Sanford, Florida. It leaves Lorton. Virginia around 4 PM and arrives in Sanford. Florida around 8 AM and includes dinner and breakfast. As of 28 April 2023 the round trip coach is \$988.00, while upper train car rooms start at \$1,732.00. This is the last MCA Grand National show of 2023. Several local Mustang clubs, their members and Mustangs and I took the train for MCA's Grand National show at Walt Disney World in September 2013. By the way their steaks were tender and delicious.

Our Fall show is now published in "Mustang Times" website, Events under 38th Annual date, and in our local Car Club Council of Central Virginia website (CCCCVA) under Calendar.

In May's issue of *Mustang Times* is a magnificent article, with pictures, on how the 1st Mustangs were being built. Many of those pictures were taken from the Ford Dearborn Assembly Plant (DAP); April 4, 1964 showing

the Mustangs being assemble on pages 12 to 20 and the inside back cover of the magazine. In May 2004, I had the privilege of being on that assemble line as the last Mustangs were being assembled before Ford closed the assemble line down as stated in the magazine article. It was converted to start assembling the F150 trucks. As the last Mustangs come down the line, a V8 engine with the automatic transmission attached, was lowered into the body of the Mustang, as it moved along the assemble line I saw, in 48 seconds, the engine and transmission installed and the Mustang continued down the line.

"Mustang Times" magazine is the official club publication for members only and is included with your Worldwide membership of around 18,000 and growing. The magazine has beautiful colored pictures, articles and great stories, Mustang modifications, and information from our President, Jeff Mays, editor; Donald Farr, and Judges Corner on pages 4, 6 and 8. As a member you can advertise your Ford parts you want to get rid or sale your Mustang at no charge or buy another Mustang listed on pages 78 to 79. You are also eligible to use Ford's discounted X plan as explained in November's 2022 issue of "Mustang Times" under DRIVER'S SEAT, 4th paragraph, page 4.


