Mustang Club of America report:

From my home to all my CVMC members and their families have a *beautiful* fun filled Christmas and

a FANTASTIC NEW YEAR.

When this was written on 23 November, you and MCA's other clubs (*which many National Directors are a member of*) have raised, let's make that *DONATED*, over \$31,000.00 to many charities out there doing a world of good for the people in the flooded areas.

I sent the following to MCA Headquarters: Thanks Jim, at our monthly club meeting, we did announce what you forwarded to me and the Club challenged our members saying if our members donated to the Helene Relief Challenge anything over \$1,000.00 our club treasury would match, so our membership donated \$1,665.00 and the club added \$1,000.00 to make it a total of \$2,665.00. Our President, Ms. Kathy McWilliams, then reviewed all the different Charities and found United Way of Southwest Virginia, SWVA Regional Disaster Relief Fund which is where the \$2,665.00 was donated. That way the donated funds stayed in the state of Virginia to help the SW part of Virginia which was hit hard.

If any of you are wondering what MCA has accomplished in 2024, for the time, below is a list of those accomplishments

- A new contract for the Office Managers to cover 2024 and 2025.
- A new Webmaster
- Approved a National Show for the Jacksonville Mustang Club April 3-5, 2026 at J-Tech Institute in Jacksonville, FL.
- Approved a National Show for Green Country Classic Mustangs of Tulsa, OK "Mustangs on the Mother Road" July 24-26, 2026.
- Approved a National Show for the Mississippi Coast Mustang Club April 23-25, 2027 in Gulfport, MS.
- Posted the latest updated Judging classes and rules on the website.
- After discussion on mailing costs that have risen five times in three years and are exceeding the costs of membership magazine mailings both nationally and internationally a motion was approved to raise the price for the Standard Members to \$60.00 with the same percentages for multi-year subscriptions. (also by motion, need to raise international memberships rates to \$120.00 (US) effective January 1, 2025)
- Club Charter brought in a new club: The Wild Stallions Mustang and Ford Car Club, representing the Brooklyn, NY area and two clubs requested removal from the Club membership: The Ponies of the Piedmont (NC) and Thunder Valley Mustang Club (TN)
- Discussion was held with the Board members and the Office Administrator on Regional Clubs not following proper procedures when applying for Insurance. *The Regional Director(You) are the Club Liaison* and the *only one* that is to apply for items through the office and <u>annual updates must be completed in advance</u> before making any requests.
- (Speaking of your club updates for 2025, if your club has elections any time going forward, you can send the updates in starting Nov 1st. Make sure your officers have valid MCA numbers, preferably for the year so a July show insurance application isn't held because they expire in June. Plan ahead!)
- With regard to judging...Beginning in 2025, MCA will begin phasing out the Preservation class.
- MCA will <u>not</u> permit registrations that are new to the PRA class after the 2024 MCA show season. *The Motion passed*.
- Beginning in 2025, with the 2005 model-year cars, MCA will move post-Ford production cars from the concours and unrestored classes to a new, *post-production division*. To qualify for these classes, owners must present documents from the respective companies (Roush, Saleen, Shelby American, etc.) to MCA judges at MCA shows to verify the authenticity of their cars.
- Presently the Modified class has a two year wait on new models before they can be entered. The Motion is: Starting in 2025, all years will be allowed in the Modified Classes which they qualify and the two-year rule is no longer applicable.
- Judging also brought up the classes for 2025 and in the Modified class section, made the motion to change MC class to go from 2005 to 2014 and the MD class will go from 2015 to the present.
- The Board of Directors announced the purchase of a 60th Anniversary Mustang Convertible for a sweepstakes car and details have been announced. Log onto the MCA web page and get your tickets!
- We moved the Regional Directors Summit to January, when New Directors are taking over and will host it on the Annual Banquet weekend with the Mecum Auctions in Orlando. The dates will be January 10-12, 2025. Our Annual Banquet and swearing in of the Board of Directors is Friday evening, the Regional Directors Summit on Saturday and Sunday we would have the Board of Directors Annual Meeting. Please join us. All the details are in Mustang Times. (Let me know if you have any questions.)
- MCA is going to host a Driving Event/National show at the Ozarks International Raceway leading into Memorial Day weekend 2025, and will further host annual events at Ozarks International Raceway starting in 2027.
- MCA's 50th Anniversary celebration will be at Michelin Raceway/Road Braselton, Georgia. August 28-30, 202<mark>6</mark>. Driving events and National Show and more to be announced!
