I. Hot Topics/Assistance Needed

VIRGINIA INTERNATIONAL AUTO SHOW

It is time for the 2024 Virginia International Auto Show! Please consider putting your car in this indoor show. The show will be multiple days and our cars will be viewed by potentially thousands of people. The show runs from February 16-18, 2024 at the Greater Richmond Convention Center. Additional show details are below:

Move-In Schedule

Thursday, February 15 – Vehicle Move-In

- Central VA Mustang Club Members: 5:30 pm
- ALL vehicles should be in position by 6:30 7 pm (There will be time for light cleaning)

Vehicle Display Requirements

- · ¼ tank of gas or 5 gallons of gas whichever is less
- Both battery cables shall be disconnected from the terminals, bagged and/or taped; and, remain disconnected while the vehicle is inside the Facility
- Vehicle power supplies may not be reconnected during show hours
- Fuel caps must be taped shut (around outside ring of gas cap to minimize vapor leaks) or fitted with a locking cap (we use blue painters tape for this)

- Keys to all vehicles must be stored in an easily accessible location at all times. Facility's Security
 Base must have immediate access to the keys. (In the past several years we have kept our keys under the floor mats of each car. There is 24 hour security)
- Proof of insurance coverage for vehicle(s), provided upon request. In most cases your general car insurance will suffice. Make sure you have proof of insurance with you just in case someone asks for it. Most likely they will not.

Move-Out Schedule

MUSTANG CLUB OF AMERICA (MCA) REPORT

I received the following draft copy of the minutes from the last National Board of Directors meeting in 2023 held October22, 2023 in Leeds, Alabama. The President, Jeff Mays, called the meeting to order at 9 AM and welcomed the 20 Board of Directors and Regional Directors. Roll was taken by Secretary Pro-Term Joy Stegner resulting in a quorum for the start of the meeting. 8 Directors were missing with several Regional Directors attending all at their own expense along with guests.

Minutes from the July 2023 Board meeting were submitted and approved as written *without objection*.

Executive Committee Report: The chair discussed at length details related to the 60th Birthday of the Mustang. Topics covered included: Thursday set-up, off site registration, hang tags for display and MORE parking, trailer parking, Saturday's banquet at the museum, wrist bands, and several other areas of interest while answering many questions.

<u>Finance Committee Report</u>: Treasurer Al Hammond gave his report via phone. All combined accounts have been justified. Committee chairs should be receiving their budget forms for 2024 in December, but should start planning now.

COMMITTEE REPORTS:

Administrative: The committee opened with a discussion on the new contract for the MCA Office Administrator to finalize and sign in January. They are adding in previously unlisted tasks and covering the addition of an assistant to give a better view of the actual work being accomplished.

<u>Club Charter</u>: Jimmy Austin made a committee motion that the Pony Express and Classic Ford Club, LTD from Evansville, IN has requested to be re-chartered. The motion was accepted <u>without objection</u>.

Nominations/Elections: John Trsar presented the Board of Directors voting results. There were 12 vacancies for two-year terms in 2024-2025 and two vacancies for the year 2024. The following MCA members elected to fill the two-year National Director terms: George Antochy, Paul Jones, Joy Stegner, Jimmy Austin, Leon Luck, Eric

Tucker, Don Blackstock, Paul Newbourne, Chris Waddle, Patsy Brown, Eric Shirley, and Randy Weldon.

The following members are to fill the two, one-year terms in 2024: Todd Broadway and Tracy Templer.

The following member will remain available to the BOD for nomination, should any board member vacate a position during 2024: Robert Helmer.

Discussion was held about the continued low numbers of votes received and methods to encourage a larger number of members to participate.

Membership/Special Events: Don Blackstock reported we have 15,115 world-wide members with the following breakdown: Standard members: 8,888; Digital members: 4,587; Associate members: 1,533; International members: 89; and Youth members: 18.

Judging: Billy Henson reported on several rule changes recommended by the Judging Community & Committee: PCB – Rule Change – President's Choice 1964 ½ thru current – Youth: a class for students younger than driving age to be judged on Occasionally Driven (OD) - Daily Driven (DD) sheets. Points will accrue toward grill medallion when eligible to drive.

<u>PCR</u> – *Added Class* – <u>President's Choice Rental</u>: for those that want to rent a car and enter the show.

<u>ODZ</u> – Occasional Driven <u>Electric Vehicle</u>: use OD rules <u>but</u> remove items not pertaining to EV. Points on the judging sheets will be reduced accordingly.

<u>DDZ</u> – *Daily Driven Electric Vehicle*: use DD rules <u>but</u> remove items not pertaining to EV. Points on judging sheets will be reduced accordingly.

The new class designations passed *without objection*.

The new class designations passed without objection

Jeff Yergovich motioned to park EV vehicles in an area separate from the Internal Combustion Engine (ICE) vehicles to prevent potential fire hazards. This does not apply to spectator parking. Second was by Robin Paulsell. After discussion, the motion was passed without objection.

The MCA Show Requirements sheet has been updated to spell out clearly that after the car has entered the show field with a fire extinguisher, the extinguisher may be put away in easy reach for use but <u>does not</u> need to be on display where it can be kicked or run over.

Patsy Brown is stepping down as Assistant National Head Judge (ANHJ) for Classification in 2024 and Tracy Wise will replace her.

Ron Heidenreich is officially the Assistant National Head Judge (ANHJ) for Modified going forward.

<u>National Shows</u>: Chris Ponder brought a motion out of committee for a National Show in Orlando April 4-6,

2025. The location will hold 350 cars with some inside parking. Hosted by the Mid-Florida Mustang Club, Jim Lane is Chairman.

Chris had a second motion for a national show hosted by the First Tennessee Mustang Club on May 14-17, 2026. This would be at Bristol Motor Speedway with 400 cars at the event. They will do pace laps for cars. Thursday will be a demonstration of drag races. An autocross will be set up in front of the track. Both shows were approved without objection

Shows already established for 2025 are June 27-29, 2025, by the Tri-State Mustang/Ford Club of Cincinnati, OH. Secondly, the National Capital Region Mustang Club will host the Grand National Show in Fredericksburg, VA on August 29-31, 2025.

New Business

Ed Hockaday, the Ford liaison, stated that Jim Owens, his contact for the last 20 years, has moved to the GTB area and someone new is to replace him.

Old Business

Jeff Mays announced that a Lifetime Achievement Award was given to J.P. Weber at the Topeka show

Jeff requested that people sign up to help at the Ozark National show and for the 60th Birthday Show. Steve Prewitt is taking names and times you are available to work.

With no further business to discuss, the meeting was adjourned without objection at 1:30 p.m. The next meeting is scheduled to take place January 6, 2025, in Orlando, Florida.
