If something does come up, that you cannot attend the show, you can always cancel your hotel reservations within the <u>time limits</u> stated on your hotel reservation, usually within 48 hours.

CVMC began, to a year or so, after COVID-19, club events here in the Richmond, Virginia area with many club and MCA members participating and traveling to the following MCA/CVMC events: The Motor Trend International Auto show, held at the Richmond Convention Center, has for many years, always had Mustangs in that show. February 17 to 19, 2023 found Mustangs again in that show. See a picture of me on the front cover of the "Gaslight" Richmond Region AACA's club (RRAACA), as I am also member. In RRAACA's March/April magazine is the story of that show with pictures on page 11. That year CVMC was across from RRAACA as the picture will show, see attached to this back page. May 29th saw CVMC members driving our Mustangs in the rain in the National Memorial Day parade in Washington, D.C., which CVMC has participated in every year since it was started in year 2000. In June we had an MCA member Tony Hall drive his Mustang to Albuquerque, N Mexico, & in July Robin Reese drive to Plainfield, Indiana. December we had 11 Mustangs and 13 members, with relatives, travel with us to the "Wreaths across America" at the Virginia Veterans Cemetery, Amelia County House, Virginia (23002). We also participated in several Christmas Parades in the Richmond area.
