CALLING ALL SPECIAL MUSTANGS

The Central Virginia Mustang Club Board of Directors (BOD) has authorized our trailer to be re-wrapped. The design will include up to seven CVMC Mustangs, one for each Mustang generation. The Mustang generations are as follows:

1st Generation: 1964 ½ to 1973 2nd Generation: 1974 to 1978 3rd Generation: 1979 to 1993 4th Generation: 1994 to 2004 5th Generation: 2005 to 2014 6th Generation: 2015 to 2023 7th Generation: 2024

If you wish to have your Mustang considered for display on the CVMC trailer you must email Tony Hall at 95svtcobrava@comcast.net with the following information.

- 2. Contact information (email and/or phone)
- 3. A photo of your Mustang

The CVMC selection process will be as follows: a committee of three CVMC members will select the top five Mustangs from each generation. The selection committee members will not have their Mustangs considered. Then the committee will have a non-club person pull the winners from a hat.

Those selected will have to sign a waiver allowing CVMC exclusive rights to use the image of their Mustang for display on the CVMC trailer for as long as is necessary. You will also have to be available for a photo shoot with only a week's notice. We will be taking photos of the selected Mustangs from at least four different iconic locations around Richmond which will be selected by the committee.

All entries must be submitted by midnight, August 6, 2025. Get those pics in!

I have not received my draft copy of Mustang Club of America's Board of Directors 2025 April meeting and will report it to you when received. I have been in touch with MCA about our September 20th show not being published in June or July issues of Mustang Times magazine Regional Events section. The reason was CVMC's Bass Pro Show notification arrived too late to make the publishers start print date/time.

The MCA Presidents award application for <u>2024</u> was mailed June 27 and delivered to MCA Headquarters on July 7th. The award application and letter are attached for your viewing.

The MCA <u>GRAND</u> National show "Gathering of the Herd" is August 29 to 31 in Fredericksburg, Virginia is still open for registration, BUT registration closes, midnight, July <u>30</u>, 2025. I have been told there are over 300 registered Mustangs so far. The Fredericksburg host hotel; Holiday Inn <u>Conference Center</u> is still available along with the Hilton Garden Inn, and Comfort Suites but the Holiday Inn Express is sold out.

 Other MCA National and Grand National shows for 2025, 26, 27 and 28 are listed under the Events section in our website www.mustang.org.

MCA's 50th Anniversary National show will be August 28 to 30, 2026 at Michelin Raceway Road Atlanta, 5300 Winder Hwy, Braselton, GA. This will be a 3-day track event. Other activities and plans will be announced as they are developed.

To register for any of the shows you must register using MCA's registration website www.mustang.org. Everyone knows the above shows fill up fast so make your hotel reservations early. If something does come up and you cannot attend the show, you can always cancel your hotel reservations within the time limits stated on your hotel reservation, usually within 48 hours.
