The MCA Presidents award application for 2024 is just about finished and will be mail June 27.

Club publication "Mustang Times" indicates the Mustang National show in Cincinnati, Ohio, June 27 to 29, registration is closed

- The MCA <u>GRAND</u> National show "Gathering of the Herd" is August 29-31 event in Fredericksburg, Virginia is open for registration, BUT registration closes July 30, 2025.
