The car shown, a 1986 Mustang GT convertible was truly my late older brother's car of Charles (Charlie) Bruno. Yes, Charlie purchased it new from the Ford dealer and I have fond memories riding/driving the car. However, Charlie proceeded to improve (in my opinion ruin) the car by completely dismantling it over the years. It remained in pieces when he passed away on Dec 15, 2001.

My younger brother Cy and I disposed of Charlie's Mustang collection of a dozen cars with Bruce receiving the Fox-Body car. Bruce also received Charlie's beloved 1974 Ford Van which again was given to him new as a present from graduating from The Massachusetts Institute of Technology. Charlie proceeded to improve (once again ruin) another car with this van. Bruce received it in pieces and did a FANTASTIC job restoring it to former glory. (That is another story.) Charlie's "changes" to the van ruined the opportunity for any future vehicles as a gift from our parents.

Thanks again for printing the article. It brought back a lot of memories of driving the car with Charlie prior to his untimely death.
